Dear Friends,

Welcome to the Children's Cardiomyopathy Foundation (CCF)'s 16th Annual Golf Classic! We hope you enjoy the event, and you have the opportunity to reconnect with friends who share a passion for helping families affected by pediatric cardiomyopathy.

The good news is we are gaining momentum in the research field. Because of CCF's partnership with the North American Pediatric Cardiomyopathy Registry, the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute awarded \$3 million to a pediatric cardiomyopathy study we supported. In 2018, our funded research studies have yielded 16 publications in peer reviewed medical journals and seven presentations at national medical meetings.

This year, CCF partnered with the American Academy of Pediatrics to establish an early career research grant to foster the next generation of cardiomypathy researchers. Additionally, a new research funding opportunity is available through the U.S. Department of Defense Peer Review Medical Research Program because of CCF's federal advocacy work. It is the first time this government program is supporting research on cardiomypathy.

These achievements all lead to better outcomes for children with cardiomyopathy, and we are grateful for your steadfast support. Your generosity gives us the critical resources we need to improve treatments and discover cures for children living with this chronic heart disease.



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



ABOUT THE CHILDREN'S CARDIOMYOPATHY FOUNDATION

The Children's Cardiomyopathy Foundation (CCF) is a national nonprofit dedicated to finding causes and cures for pediatric cardiomyopathy, a chronic and potentially life-threatening heart disease.

The Foundation started in 2002 with one family's determination to call attention to a poorly understood disease and to take action on the lack of medical progress and public awareness. Sixteen years later, CCF has grown into a global community of families, physicians and scientists focused on improving diagnosis, treatment and quality of life for children with cardiomyopathy.

The proceeds from Golf for a Cure support CCF's Research Grant Program and partnership with the North American Pediatric Cardiomyopathy Registry. More than 260 medical publications and presentations have resulted from CCF-funded research initiatives, which have provided physicians with critical care guidelines for children with cardiomyopathy.
