

All-In For A Cure No-Limit Texas Hold 'Em Tournament

Poker Rules

- 1. Seating will begin at 6:45 pm and dealing will begin promptly at 7 pm.
- 2. Each poker table will have 8-10 players. The dealer will reassign players from time to time as tables are reduced in players.
- 3. Buy-ins or entry into the tournament will be at \$600, and players will receive \$2,500 in tournament chips to play.
- 4. The game will start with small and big blinds at \$25 and \$50 respectively. Blinds and antes will be determined by the dealer as the game progresses.
- 5. There is no limit to the amount that a player can raise.
- 6. If a player has less than \$1,300 in chips or is knocked out of the tournament, he/she may rebuy chips at \$250 (\$1,300 value in chips) or \$500 (\$2,500 value in chips). Rebuys will be allowed up to 8:30 pm, at which time all players will have the opportunity for one final rebuy regardless of chip amount.
- 7. A player must immediately rebuy after losing all chips. Otherwise he/she will be permanently out of the game.
- 8. The tournament will end when there is only one player remaining with chips. However, if no winner has been determined by 11:00 pm, CCF reserves the right to end the game.

Poker Etiquette

As with any poker tournament, the game should be friendly and polite. The dealer and your fellow players should be treated with respect. If you have any questions about proper poker protocol, please ask your dealer to review the standard poker rules and playing etiquette.
